

Picnic Shelter Guidelines

Duke Energy's World of Energy at Oconee Nuclear Station

We are delighted that you are using our picnic shelter. Please adhere to the following guidelines for your safety and to keep this area preserved.

- Grills, campfires and camping are prohibited.
- All open flames are prohibited.
- Alcoholic beverages are not permitted.
- Swimming is not allowed.
- Firearms, air guns, explosives, fireworks, etc. are unlawful to possess.
- Boaters may use the pier for docking purposes.
- Fishing is allowed. A valid South Carolina fishing license is required for persons 16 years of age or older.
- Vehicles are not allowed on or around the shelter or the access road.
- Garbage and other refuse shall be disposed of in the trash receptacles. Large groups must bring trash bags and dispose of the filled bags in the dumpster behind the World of Energy building.
- Pets must be kept on a leash or otherwise under restraint at all times.
