Re: Information on a Duke Energy pole relocation project planned for your community

Dear Neighbor,

We're writing to let you know that Duke Energy is supporting a State Route 63 (SR 63) road widening project being planned by the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) and Warren County. Our work will involve relocating and replacing approximately 100 poles that run east and west in a road right of way approximately 3 miles along SR 63. We will also replace two lattice towers that cross north and south over SR 63 in Turtlecreek Township. The replacement of the lattice towers requires review and approval by the Ohio Power Siting Board. The enclosed map shows the general project area.

Although construction is not expected to begin until spring or summer 2022, you may see Duke Energy crews in the coming months preparing for the replacements. This may include soil borings, land surveying and vegetation removal. All the work is expected to occur on ODOT right of way or on existing Duke Energy easements.

Once construction begins, drivers may see road restrictions as the project progresses. We ask that drivers slow down and use caution as they approach crews. Signage will be posted in advance of lane closures or detours, and access will be open to through traffic. The project work is expected to run through late 2022.
